- Twenty-two States had increases in the number of fatalities in crashes involving at least one driver or a motorcycle operator who had an illegal per se level (.08+) while twenty-eight states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico had decreases.
- States with largest absolute decreases:
  - Florida: -147
  - Missouri: -40
  - Pennsylvania: -39
- States with largest percentage decreases
  - Dist of Columbia: -37%
  - Alaska: -31%
  - Delaware: -16%
- States with largest increases:
  - Arizona, Kansas, Texas: +34
  - Tennessee: +32
  - Georgia: +31
- States with largest percentage increases:
  - Utah: +64%
  - Kansas: +34%
  - Iowa: +30%
  - Wyoming: +24%
